



COACH ASSESSMENT GUIDE

FOR THE NET GENERATION PLAYTRACKER



In order to get started, coaches must be USPTA or PTR certified and in good standing with their organization to assess players aged 7-8 years old from orange to green ball.

BELOW ARE THE STEPS TO ASSESS A PLAYER:

- Download the Net Generation app.
- Complete Safe Play or renew your Safe Play status.
- Complete your coach profile on usta.com.
- Insert your USPTA or PTR member certification number, within your usta.com account.
- Share your profile with a player.
 - In the Net Generation app, click on the profile icon in the top left and then select connect.
 - The parent/player must be the one to initiate the connection request through the app.
- Ensure your player has listed you as their primary coach.
- Select the Orange Level 1, Green Level 2 or Green Level 1 Assessment and watch the 25 minute training video.
 - This video is only required to be watched once and will instruct you on how and when to carry out an assessment.
- Complete the appropriate assessment for your player.
- Players must score 85% or above to successfully pass the assessment.
- If the player passes the assessment, immediately select to change the player skill level to match the level in which the assessment was completed. For example, if the Orange Level 1 Assessment was successfully completed, the skill level would change to Orange Level 1.
- Players can now register for a green ball competitive event.
