

Details:	The USTA will be awarding one (1) men's singles main draw wild card into 2019 Roland Garros based on performance in any professional outdoor clay (Har-Tru or Red Clay) ATP Challenger Tour level events & above in the world. The wild card will be awarded to the American player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles ranking points from their best three (3) results – including points earned in qualifying and main draw: • Players' best three (3) singles results including points earned in qualifying and main draw for any outdoor clay (Har-Tru or Red Clay) ATP Challenger Tour level event & above in the world listed below during a four (4) week time period. Weeks of April 8, April 15, April 22 & April 29 will be used and combined to calculate the point total. • In the event of a tie, the player with the best ATP singles ranking in the published ATP rankings on Monday, May 6, 2019 will be awarded the wild card. • Should the player with the highest total of cumulative ATP singles points from their best three (3) results become a Direct Acceptance into Roland Garros, the next eligible American player with the highest cumulative ATP singles points from their best three (3) results will be awarded the wild card (ties will be broken as described above). • In the event that issues arise that are not covered by these rules, USTA Player Development will be the final arbiter.
Eligibility:	 At the time of the April 8 published ATP rankings, players ranked within the Top #50 ATP will not be eligible in the Wild Card Challenge. Players who are USA passport holders and are eligible to represent the United States in Davis Cup competition in 2019 are eligible to be considered for the singles main draw wildcard. The minimum age for eligibility is 14. There is no maximumage restriction.
