



## ACROSS

- Match played by four players, two per side of the court
- A stroke in which the player misses the ball completely
- Person designated to enforce the rules of the game during play
- Forehand or backhand shot
- The result of hitting the ball in an unintentional manner
- To win a game as the receiving player or team
- Stroke in which the player hits the ball over his head

## DOWN

- A small rubber device affixed to the strings of the racquet
- Material woven through the face of the racquet
- Term for a clay court specialist
- Portion of the racquet that contains strings
- Area designated for playing a game of tennis
- A way of holding the racquet in order to hit shots during a match
- Serve that fails to land in the service box
- Serve that is not touched by the receiver
