## Format: Round Robin

Best of two tie-break sets with a Match Tie-break if required; no coaching allowed. The Match Tie-break shall be scored as 1 set and 1 game for tie-break procedures. Two-minute set rest between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> set and between the 2<sup>nd</sup> set and 3<sup>rd</sup> set match tie-break. Coman Tie-break Procedure for Set and Match Tie-breaks.

Eligibility:	A minimum of four (4) players who were on the final local roster must be available to compete at section for 3.0 – 4.5 levels and a minimum of three (3) players for 2.5 and 5.0 levels. If a team is coming short, they should inform both their District League Coordinator and the Section Coordinator in advance of the event.
	A player is eligible to advance to sectional championship competition if that player has played on the same team in at least two (2) matches through the local league season. A maximum of one default shall count for advancing.
	All individual team members must be at the appropriate level of play in accordance with the National Tennis Rating Program (NTRP) system.
	USTA Rules and Regulations, USTA/Midwest Section Standing Orders pertaining to USTA Leagues, and USTA/Midwest Section Championship Rules and Regulations will be enforced during the championship.
Procedures in the event of a tie:	<ul> <li>The tie will be broken by the first of the following procedures:</li> <li>Winner of the most individual matches in the entire competition</li> <li>Winner of head-to-head match</li> <li>Loser of the fewest number of sets</li> <li>Loser of the fewest number of games</li> <li>Highest game winning percentage</li> <li>Fewest sets lost in the head-to-head matches</li> <li>Fewest games lost in the head-to-head matches</li> <li>Highest game winning percentage in the head-to-head matches</li> <li>A coin toss by the head referee or designee</li> </ul>
Balls:	Penn hard court balls will be provided.
Rain:	<u>Referee and Tournament Director</u> will decide if the championship goes to rain mode. The Tournament Championship Committee has the option to change format and/or schedule in case of unusual circumstances.
Athletic Trainers:	One (1) athletic trainer will be onsite during play.
Photographs:	Photographs will not be taken for all teams. We will take photos of winning teams. Pictures will be made available online.
