#### **Tournament Awards:**

Staff compiles list of eligible candidates and information related to award criteria. Straw vote of ATC determines winner.

### Adult Tournament Director of the Year:

Awarded annually to a Tournament Director of an Adult Open, Age Group, Family and/or NTRP Tournament.

- Awarded to the tournament director that hosted the most tournaments and the combined rating of the tournaments is above 4.0 (80%) satisfaction, with a minimum of 25% of the participants submitting an evaluation.
- Tournament Director not eligible if the Organization Member holding a sanction for any tournament (any division) in which the person served as Tournament Director had been put on probation or suspension during the calendar year.
- Written feedback on tournament evaluations shall be considered by ATC Committee.
- ATC Committee shall consider feedback from player survey taken at Grand Prix.

#### Outstanding NTRP Tournament of the Year:

Awarded annually to the Organization Member sanction holder of an NTRP Tournament.

#### Outstanding Age Group Tournament of the Year:

Awarded annually to the Organization Member sanction holder of an Age Group Tournament.

### Outstanding Open Tournament of the Year:

Awarded annually to the Organization Member sanction holder of an Adult Open Tournament.

## Outstanding Family Tournament of the Year:

Awarded annually to the Organization Member sanction holder of a Family Tournament.

- Organization Member holding sanction must be current USTA member.
- Tournament not eligible if Organization Member holding sanction had been put on probation or suspension for any tournament (any division) during the calendar year. Tournaments with a player evaluation rating of a 4.0 or higher with 25% or more of the participants submitting an evaluation, shall be considered for this award. If no tournament meets this criterion the ATC may select a tournament with a lower rating and/or participant participation rate or declare that there shall be no recipient for the year.
- Written feedback on tournament evaluations shall be considered by ATC Committee.
- ATC Committee shall consider feedback from player survey taken at Grand Prix.
