



USTA League Refund Policy

USTA League Refunds will only be given for the following circumstances:

- Documented injury or other medical issue by a medical professional for a player who has not played a match during the current league season.
- Team unable to play a match. This may include not enough players to register at the start of season, not enough teams for the flight to have a league, etc.
- Extraordinary circumstance as approved by the USTA PNW Director of Provider Services/SLC.

Players may transfer registration fees within the same Championship Year. This must be done through the Regional League Coordinator.

Reasons refunds will not be considered include, but are not limited to the following:

- Season is complete but the player did not play a match due to unavailability or other reasons outside of medical issues.
- Captain chose not to play the player.
